
Luffing/Proper Course Basics

If the windward boat overlaps you from clear astern you can luff them. i.e. you have luffing rights


There's no rule that says you HAVE to sail a 'proper course ... just rules that say sometimes you cannot sail above or below your proper course.

PROPER COURSE: The course you would sail to finish ASAP.

Familiar luffing match on a reach





Even on a beat, if you have luffing rights you can go head to wind.




What are you going to do if you get into this situation? That's why you should practice dial-ups

If you overlap to leeward from clear astern you DO NOT get luffing rights
